La del Programa de las Naciones Unidas para el Medio Ambiente aparece como PNUMA y como UNEP. La de la Organización para la Cooperación y el Desarrollo Económicos aparece como OCDE y como OECD. La de la Organización Meteorológica Mundial aparece como OMM y como WMO. La Organización Mundial de la Salud aparece como WHO y como OMS. Este criterio no lo he utilizado para aquellos organismos cuyas siglas en inglés son utilizadas habitualmente en los documentos en castellano; tal es el caso de la Organización de Naciones Unidas para la Agricultura y la Alimentación, cuyos documentos, tanto en castellano como en inglés, los cito siempre como FAO. Igualmente, el Grupo Intergubernamental de Expertos sobre Cambio Climático está citado siempre como IPCC; la Convención de Naciones Unidas para la Lucha contra la Desertificación se cita siempre como UNCCD; la Oficina de Naciones Unidas para la Reducción del Riesgo de Desastres se cita como UNISDR. En cambio, utilizo solo las siglas NNUU (en castellano) para los documentos de Naciones Unidas que no son de una agencia específica, sean en inglés o en castellano.

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
